Layout of booklets

Each booklet has the contents listed according to repair operations and items to make it easy to find the information required.

The technical data is followed by a description of the repair operations. Where practical, each operation is preceded by an exploded view which also contains all the main repair instructions. This is supplemented, where

Technical information should always be made available to all foremen and mechanics because compliance with the instructions given is essential to ensure vehicle roadworthiness and safety. In addition, the normal safety precautions to be observed when working on motor vehicles are also applicable.

necessary, by photographs – which are referred to in the exploded view – giving details of the fitting positions of parts or showing special tools in use. If a definite sequence has to be followed when dismantling and assembling a component, the exploded view is followed by a description of the main steps of the work sequence. Any adjustments required are also explained.
